REGIONAL PARK REGULATIONS & RATES

PARK REGULATIONS

1. No person shall:
 - (a) deface or litter the park or park facilities, or their campsite during their stay;
 - (b) disturb their neighbours with undue noise and disruption between the hours of 11 p.m. and 7 a.m.;
 - (c) allow their pets or children to roam unsupervised such that it disturbs the peace and enjoyment of other campers or the natural values of the park;
 - (d) allow dogs to run at large and they must be on a leash;
 - (e) leave fires unattended;
 - (f) stay more than 14 days without the permission of the Campsite Caretaker;
 - (g) use the park for commercial purposes without the permission of the Board of the Regional District.
 - (h) use ATV's or non licensed motor/dirt bikes in the campsite area.
2. Only one RV or vehicle is permitted per campsite. Other arrangements must be made directly with the Campsite Caretaker.
3. All visitors must register with the Campsite Caretaker.
4. All garbage must be securely bagged and placed in garbage disposal facilities provided.

PARK RATES

<u>Link River Regional Park</u>	Un-serviced sites:\$15 per night
<u>Bere Point Regional Park</u>	Un-serviced sites:\$15 per night
<u>Kwaksistah Regional Park</u>	Un-serviced sites:\$15 per night
<u>Broughton Strait Regional Park</u> (year-round)	Serviced sites: \$22 per night Un-serviced sites:\$15 per night
Park Reservation Fee:	\$5 per site reserved plus first night stay = \$20

- All fees are payable in advance. At this time, cash is the only method of payment accepted at Link River and Kwaksistah regional parks. Personal cheques will not be accepted.
- Reservation fees are non-refundable and are in addition to campsite rates. Persons holding reservations must check in with the Campsite Caretaker by 6:00 p.m. or risk losing their campsite. Reservations are accepted by the Regional District of Mount Waddington office for Link River, Bere Point and Kwaksistah regional parks. Reservations for Broughton Strait Regional Park are made directly with the Campsite Caretaker.
- Checkout time is 11 a.m. Persons wishing to re-register must do so prior to checkout.
- *Regional Parks, or portions thereof, may at any time be closed to the public for reasons such as fire hazard or vandalism.*
- *Persons violating any Park Regulation will be asked by the Campsite Caretaker to leave and may be barred from future use of the park. Disputes can be made in writing to the Regional District of Mount Waddington, Att: Administrator, Box 729, Port McNeill, BC V0N 2R0.*
