



# LITTLE HUSON CAVE REGIONAL PARK



Nestled in the Nimpkish Valley, just a 20 minute drive off the Island Highway, Little Huson Cave Park features limestone and rock arch formations that Northern Vancouver Island has to offer.

A short trail through the woods from the parking lot brings you to a platform overlooking a unique rock bridge and deep pools filled with clear green water from Little Huson Lake.

View the spectacular cave formations by the lake or walk the trail to see the magnificent limestone arches and rock platforms. Sponsored and developed by the Regional

District of Mount Waddington. Little Huson Cave Park offers just a small taste of the many caves and limestone features that form part of the Quatsino formation that runs through much of Northern Vancouver Island.

Other caves such as the Benson Lake system, Vanishing River and the Eternal Fountain can be found in the area, and are easily located on maps provided by the different logging company offices or the Ministry of Forest office in Port McNeill.

Other features in the area include campsites at nearby Anutz and Atluck Lake. Canoeists especially, will enjoy the beauty of the lakes in summer and vegetation along the shores.

Enjoy a picnic in amongst the trees and on the shore of the lake. It's beautiful!

Curious travelers might wish to continue down the road to scenic Zeballos, a town that still retains much of its gold mining history.

Further down the road to Zeballos, one can reach the wharf at Fair Harbour, gateway to the West Coast and many canoeing and kayaking opportunities.
