## REGIONAL PARK CAMPSITE



Link River campsite is open from the middle of June to after the Labour Day weekend in September with Parks Maintenance. For the rest of the year the campground is user maintained.

Link River Regional Park campsite has 24 sites for your enjoyment. There is no potable running water, hydro or sewer. Please ensure you bring adequate drinking water with you.

Link River flows into Alice Lake and provides a great beach for swimming. As well, a boat launch and three sheltered barbeque sites are available for your use.



### CAMPGROUND AMENITIES

Swimming is at your own risk as there are no Life Guards on duty.

Fishing off shore or by boat is another feature we boast about.

Each campsite has a fire pit for your enjoyment and there is free firewood available **while stocks last**. You are camping amongst a dense forest of trees and at times there may be a campfire ban due to extreme dry weather conditions. Please obey all posted signs.

Outhouses are provided and are accessible to those with mobility challenges. They are kept clean for your use, please use them. There is limited cell phone service at Link River.

### DAY-USE/PICNIC AREA

A day-use area with picnic tables is also available. There is no charge for this use.

Other features in the area include the stunning Alice Lake Loop Karst driving tour with stops like River to Nowhere, Eternal Fountain and Devil's Bath not far away.

Curious campers might want to check out beautiful Port Alice - a small village located on Neroutsos Inlet. They offer a challenging Golf Course as well.

### RATES AND RESERVATIONS

Reservations aren't required but are recommended especially for long weekends or for lakefront/riverside sites. A reservation service fee of \$5 plus first night stay (=\$20) will secure a site for you. Please note that reservation fees are non-refundable. All sites are \$15 per night on a first come, first served basis. To reserve please call the Regional District of Mount Waddington at 250-956-3301.
