5) **New Business: Civic Addressing Scheme for Quatsino**

- **Background Presentation for the Quatsino Numbering System: Gwen Hansen:** This Addressing system has been in place since 2006, when it was implemented for our Emergency Preparedness Plan. Gwen has numbered all the properties in the Quatsino Area on a map provided by the Mount Waddington Regional District (Jeff Long). These numbers will then be superimposed on an official Regional District Map. This scheme will replace our old “General Delivery” Addressing System.
- The Government Wharf will mark the center of the Community, and properties will be East (E) or West (W) of the Wharf. Property Numbers are 3 digits long. The 1<sup>st</sup> number indicates the homestead block, the 2<sup>nd</sup> number indicates the general location within the block or driveway

and the last number indicates whether the home is on the waterfront side of the Rd. (5) or above the Rd. (0).

- The main road will be Quatsino Road. Bergh Road, Evenson Road, Wharf Road and Leeson Point Road will all be official Road names on the map.
- Foreshore Leases (FS) will have their own address, as will Akre Island.
- Addresses west of Mark Van Mulligan's will be included with Quatsino Road as will Quattishe Reserve.
- The 3 Cemeteries will each have their own address.
- Don Avis' Properties near Dish Rag Lake will likely be rezoned to be included within Area C, instead of being located within the Winter Harbour's Area B, as they are at present.

A **Motion** was then made by **Debbie McNabb**, requesting that the **Regional District accept the Addressing Scheme as presented at the June 13th meeting by Gwen Hansen, and undertake a Civic Addressing Scheme and create a Civic Address Map for Quatsino.**

The **Motion** was 2<sup>nd</sup> by **Donnie Botel** and **Carried**.

Once the Addressing Scheme has been finalized by the Regional District, they will contact everyone by mail with their official address. 911, BC Ambulance, BC Hydro, Telus and the RCPM will also be notified. Gwen will be printing out the new numbers and names for our Emergency Dispatch Book.
