2) Island Health Capital Plan -

The plan discusses how capital funding is accessed as well as book cost, replacement cost and sustainability costs for capital assets.

The report highlights the facility condition of the assets, with many built in the 1980's are in either the "poor" or "critical" listing. There is a systemic issue with maintenance budgets being cut, which leads to the issues listed in the facility condition report, as well as budgeting where maintenance is stopped once the amoratizaiton period is complete.

This report highlights the potential that in 10 to 15 years, Mount Waddington Regional Hospital District may have to cover 40% of \$130,000,000 (or \$52 million) identified for replacement of the Port Hardy and Cormorant Island hospitals.

The following information was presented regarding the proposed proclamation for World Elder Abuse Awareness Day:

- Mount Waddington Collaborative Plan for promoting the protection of Vulnerable Adults from the Community Response Network (CRN).
- This is a partnership between the CRN, Port Hardy Seniors and the Mount Waddington Health Network.
- It has been recognized that in the Mount Waddington region that "self-neglect" is a definitive issue.
- There is an operational plan with 3 key events, including WEAAD (World Elder Awareness Abuse Day) on June 15.
- The hope is that if this is supported throughout the region, it would unlock funding in the amount of \$3,000, along with a potential of an additional \$2,000 for coordination and up to \$10,000 for additional works.
- The proclamation would be to fly a flag, hang a banner, read out the proclamation.

- There will also be an ask sent out to all the municipalities in the Regional District.
