



REGIONAL DISTRICT OF MOUNT WADDINGTON BYLAW NO. 798

A bylaw to provide a waste management service for the control, collection and disposal of garbage and recyclables generated in the community of Winter Harbour

WHEREAS the *Local Government Act* empowers a regional district to operate any service that its Board considers necessary or desirable for all or part of the regional district;

AND WHEREAS the Board of the Regional District of Mount Waddington wishes to establish a service for the purpose of providing waste management on Winter Harbour;

AND WHEREAS in, accordance with Section 797.4 of the *Local Government Act* and Section 212 of the *Community Charter*, the Regional District of Mount Waddington has received a sufficient petition from Winter Harbour property owners to proceed with a waste management local service;

AND WHEREAS the Director of Electoral Area "B" has consented to the establishment of the service area;

NOW THEREFORE the Board of the Regional District of Mount Waddington in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. **Service**

The Regional District of Mount Waddington hereby establishes a service area to provide solid waste and recycling collection and transfer station services on Winter Harbour, to be known as the "Winter Harbour Waste Management Service Area" (the "Service").

2. **Boundaries**

The boundaries of the Service Area is that portion of Electoral Area "B" as shown outlined on Schedule "A" (the "Service Area") attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw.

3. **Participating Areas**

The "Participating Area" for the Service is Electoral Area "B".

4. **Cost Recovery**

The annual costs of providing the service shall be recovered by one or more of the following:

- a. The imposition of fees and charges that may be fixed by separate bylaw for the purpose of recovering these costs;
- b. The imposition of a property value tax; and
- c. Revenues received by way of agreement, enterprise, gift, grant or otherwise.

5. **Maximum Requisition**

The maximum annual amount that may be requisitioned for the **Service** is the greater of \$10,000 or the sum that could be raised from a property value tax of \$0.80 per one thousand dollars of net taxable assessment.

6. **Powers**

To operate this service, the Regional District may:

- a) Acquire land and/or equipment necessary to provide a waste management collection, recycling and transfer system;
- b) enter into service agreements for the provision and maintenance of the service;
- c) by bylaw, establish a Winter Harbour Waste Management Advisory Committee for the purpose of providing advice with respect to operation of the service;


7. **Effective Dates**

This Bylaw takes effect December 31, 2010.

8. **Citation**

This Bylaw may be cited as the "Regional District of Mount Waddington Winter Harbour Waste Management Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 798, 2010".

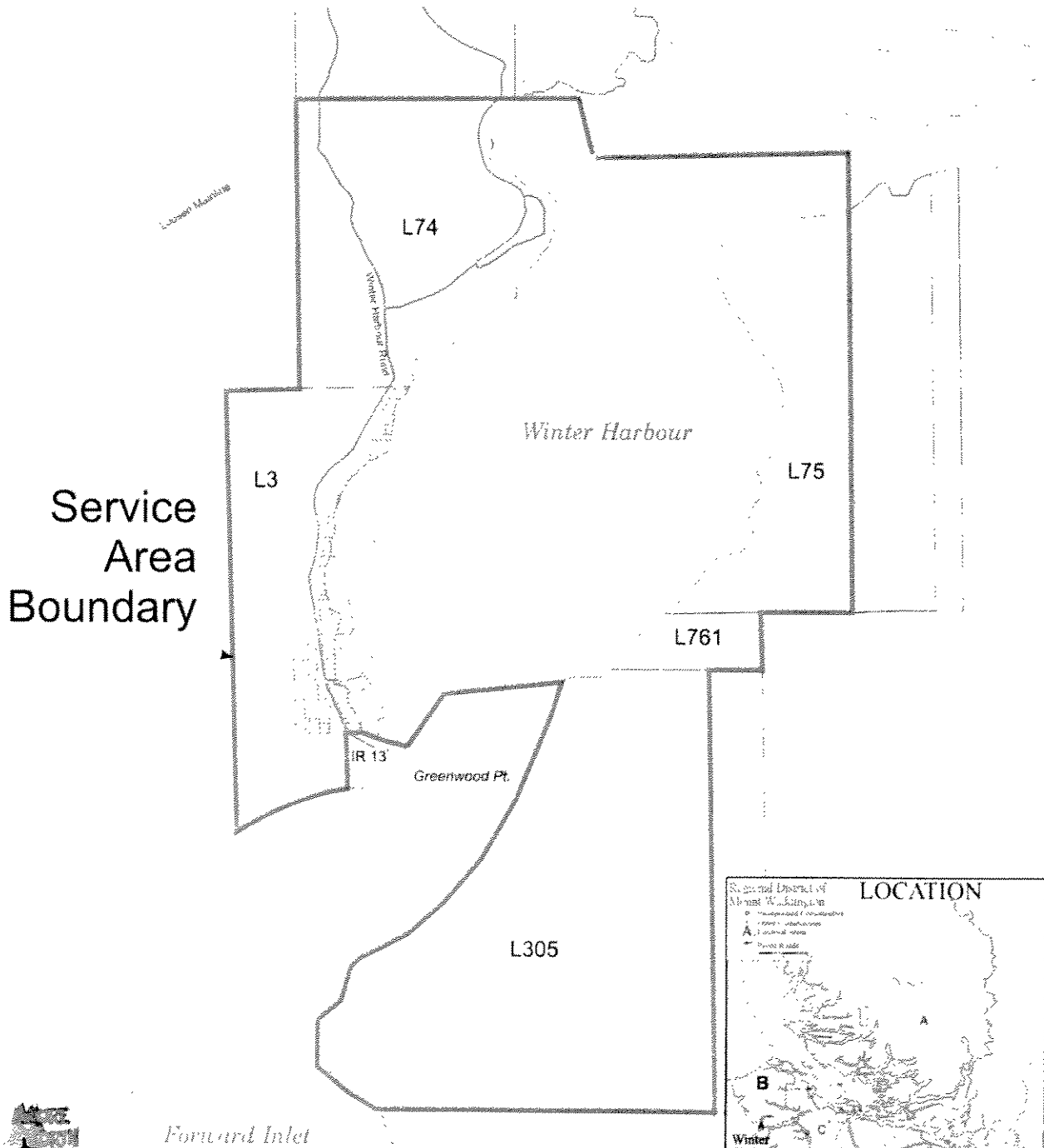
